Hello Albert Park Community Member

As you are aware Albert Park FLC has resumed face to face classes. As of the 25th May 2020 all Queensland schools will be open and students will receive face-to-face learning within the classroom environment. Schools will not be expected to lead dual (face-to-face and home-based) modes of teaching and learning.

Albert Park FLC has taken steps to reduce the risk of CoVid 19 including the provision of hand sanitiser to be used when entering each space, antibacterial cleaning of touchpoints prior to each session and the provision to young people of antibacterial wipes for keyboards and computer mice.

Students who are **unable** to return to school due to medical reasons will be supported by Albert Park FLC, just as they would in the case of any extended student medical absence. Albert Park FLC will determine the most appropriate approach, taking into account the expected duration of absence, the student's learning needs, available tools and resources, and the school's established approach to supporting continuity of learning.

Where a parent **decides** to keep their child home, or an independent young person **decides** to remain at home, due to concerns about COVID-19, both supervision and continuity of learning are the responsibility of the parent, carer or independent young person. Albert Park FLC can offer advice about appropriate learning activities that can be undertaken, and they may choose to offer additional support based on the circumstances, but the classroom teacher is not responsible for providing a home-based learning program for these students.

In either case appropriate communication with Albert Park FLC is required. Contact details are below. The parent/carer or independent young person is required to provide the school with advice as to why the young person is being kept home and the dates of which they will be absent. In this case written advice will need to be provided. Their attendance is then marked as an explained absence (for Term 2 2020). This will be revised at the end of Term 2.
